Foundation, but without compensation for time and/or service; and shall relinquish and deliver to the Miss Rodeo Oregon Inc. Foundation, all claims and accouterments (crown, banners and banner pin, buckle, saddle, breast collar, etc.) as shall relate to the title of Miss Rodeo Oregon, all upon the naming of a successor to such title.

This agreement shall be binding upon all heirs, assigns, successors, trustees, receivers, legally appointed guardians, administrators, executors and personal representatives of the Miss Rodeo Oregon Pageant, Miss Rodeo Oregon Inc. Foundation, and the undersigned.

Educational Scholarship – a scholarship will be awarded by MROIF to the following:

- Miss Rodeo Oregon

Any scholarship awarded during the MRO Pageant is governed by the following order and procedures set forth by the MROIF Scholarship Committee.

Scholarship information will be made available to all participants in the MRO Pageant.

Order and Procedures for Awarding Miss Rodeo Oregon Scholarship

Recipient must meet pageant eligibility and pageant requirements. Recipient must also have completed and signed the Miss Rodeo Oregon application, all applicable waivers/releases, paid all applicable fees and completed sales requirements. In addition, contestant must successfully complete the annual Miss Rodeo Oregon Pageant in good standing as a pageant contestant while abiding by all rules and regulations set forth by the pageant committee and Miss Rodeo Oregon Inc. Foundation.

Recipient of the Miss Rodeo Oregon Scholarship must also complete the duties of her title that are required of her through her performance contract, including competing at the Miss Rodeo America Pageant.

Funds shall reside with MROIF, and will be paid directly to the college, university or trade school designated by the recipient.

Funds can be used for the following:

To be disbursed to a school loan financial institution to pay existing school loans.

To be disbursed for the recipient to attend a seminar/conference for career advancement.

To be disbursed to a college, university or trade school after the recipient has a completed a term with a 2.0 GPA or better.

No funds will be paid to directly to a recipient.

Recipient has one year from the completion of her reign as Miss Rodeo Oregon to use her awarded scholarship. If the titleholder should be selected as Miss Rodeo America, she will have two years from the completion of her reign as Miss Rodeo Oregon.

Scholarship is not renewable.

Should the recipient not use the awarded scholarship, the scholarship shall revert to MROIF.

THE MISS RODEO OREGON INC. FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE AND THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS RESERVES THE RIGHT TO INTERPRET OR AMEND THESE ORDERS AND PROCEDURES AT ANY TIME AT ITS DISCRETION AND TO SETTLE AND DETERMINE ALL DISPUTES, QUESTIONS OR MATTERS REGARDING, ARISING FROM, OR INCIDENT TO THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM.
