Rules & Eligibility:

Essay must be anonymous and not contain any personal indicators. An aspiration or acceptance to a school or a program, as well as a major or course of study is <u>not</u> considered a personal indicator and can be mentioned in your essay should you choose.

(1) \$500 Scholarship will be awarded annually. The Protect the Harvest Scholarship Winner is subject to all provisions of the scholarship acknowledgement letter provided in the contestant application.

To be eligible for the Protect the Harvest Scholarship, you must be a contestant of a Miss Rodeo Oregon Pageant. If you do not complete the competition, the scholarship will be forfeited and awarded to the runner up selected by the selection committee.

The winner of the Protect the Harvest Scholarship will not receive any additional benefits for their competition in the pageant, including but not limited to points towards the title.
